

Georgia Hunting and Fishing Federation Scholarship Fund

Qualifications for applying:

A parent, guardian, or grandparent of the student, or the student must be a member of GHFF.

Applicants must plan to major in a field related to hunting, fishing or wildlife.

Applicants must be a senior in high school who has been accepted to an accredited college or vocational/technical school in Georgia or an undergraduate student attending any accredited college, university or vocational/technical school in the state of Georgia.

Applicants will be selected on the basis of academic achievement, school citizenship, school and community involvement, and a written essay.

The application package must include the following:

1. A completed application form
2. Two letters of recommendation – one from a teacher and one from a member of the community
3. High school transcript (or college transcript if an undergraduate)
4. Essay --- 500 to 1000 words to include:
 - What are your career goals after graduating from college?
 - What do you hope to accomplish and how do you see the prospects of a higher education affecting your career goals and the rest of your life?
 - How has hunting, fishing and wildlife affected your life and how will your education affect the future of the outdoors?

The application package must be completed and mailed to GHFF, P.O. Box 154, Hoboken, GA 31542, and postmarked no later than March 1, 2009. Scholarship funds of \$500 will be awarded to the winning applicants.
